- 1. **Deadline for subscriptions** 11/06/2019
- 2. **Subscriptions** Please submit the subscription form directly to the ITF entering the IPIN code owned by the player. - 3. **Subscription fee**: Singular 50 € (one singular and two doubles). The payment of the fees will occur on site.
- 4. **The matches** will be played on 4 red clay outdoors courts and possibly on two indoor red clay courts. The start time is at 9.00 and the matches could take place in nighttime. There will be used DUNLOP FORT balls.
- 5. **Rules for the double**: the matches will be a best-of-three sets with killer points. The decisive set will be played with a tie break at 10 points

## The Club

The "Giorgio Maggioni" Tennis Club is located in central San Benedetto del Tronto, surrounded by a green area along Viale Bruno Buozzi, at 100 mt. from the sea.

Over the 70-80 decades, it hosted for several years international tournaments with the attendance of the best players worldwide, ranging from Panatta, Bertolucci, Nastase. The climax of such a golden age was reached in 1976 when the Maggioni Tennis Club hosted the Coppa-Davis match Italy-Netherlands.

Today the Sanbenedetto Tennis Cup is permanently scheduled in the ATP calendar with a challenger, the past edition offered a winning prize of 70.000 €, and whose annals feature names like Stanislas Wawrinka and Fabio Fognini, Italy's number 1 and 15 in the world ranking.

The facility provides 9 courts, 7 in red clay and 2 in artificial grass, (6 provided with balloon coverage in wintertime), 2 Padel courts, a club house, a gym with fitness equipment and a playground area with table tennis and foosball.

The Tennis Club counts currently 250 members and the tennis school has 8 instructors and 120 pupils.











### The Town

Known as the capital of the "Palms' Riviera", "Riviera delle Palme", San Benedetto del Tronto is a seaside resort in the region of Marche – in the province of Ascoli Piceno – visited every summer by thousands of tourists.

It is famous for the waterfront, embellished by sculptures, gardens and artworks and for the many outdoors activities.

SBT has been famous since the 1800 for its beautiful **liberty style palaces** and the palms lining the waterfront, around 8.000 trees; different new species have been planted in the recent years.

Not only: **San Benedetto's sea has been awarded with the "Blue Flag" prize,** the recognition to the most beautiful, environment respectful and sustainable seaside places in EU. This makes the town one of the most sought after holyday goals by tourists in Italy.

Don't miss beside the waterfront: the old house district, the Jonathan's way, the harbour.

In the surroundings the amazing villages of Grottammare, Ripatransone, Offida and the main city of the province, the stunning Ascoli Piceno.

# How to get there

S. Benedetto del Tronto, along the Adriatica Highway, is easily to be reached out from all over Italy.

The Autostrada A/14 Highway (Bologna - Taranto) is provided by two exits: Ascoli Piceno-S. Benedetto from Southern Italy and Grottammare from Northern Italy.

Coming from Rome, drive trhough A/24 (Roma - L'Aquila) up to Giulianova and then take the A/14.

The railway station has frequent connections with other ferry routes: to Milan, Bologna, Ancona, Lecce and the Rome-Falconara-Ancona
